



8-week digital mentoring program Paper Writing Academy

Paper Writing Academy™ (PWA) is an 8-week digital mentoring program supporting early-career researchers in preparing and writing a research paper to be successfully published in an international, peer-reviewed journal. Participants learn step-by-step all the relevant stages in the preparation, writing, editing, submission, and peer-review process. They are guided through the process of paper writing through the program. They make weekly progress on their research paper, and can complete it by the end of the program, ready for journal submission. During PWA, participants adopt a specific roadmap of productive paper-writing to guide them in future publications throughout their academic life.

Course concept

The course facilitates hands-on-learning while writing on a manuscript. It is provided through an e-learning platform. Participants work independently using the provided material. The course contains

- 8 weeks of guided course lessons
- 8 learning modules and 35 lessons
- 1 kick-off meeting
- 4 live-support sessions
- online discussion group to clarify problems
- virtual writing room for participants

The approach of not just working theoretically, but doing the work during the course saves an incredible amount of time. The actual time that the participants need to view the video and PDF material provided and to participate in the sessions can be estimated at 1-3 hours per week, an amount of time that can be integrated into any work week.

Requirements

To benefit from PWA, participants should work on a paper, i.e. from scratch, being stuck or having a paper rejected.

PWA by TRESS ACADEMIC will be rolled out 3 times in 2023, with courses starting on

- October 9, 2023

The program schedule is flexible so that participants work at their own pace and when it suits them best.
